1. Exclusion of Press and Public.

The Panel resolved, in terms of Section 50(A)(4) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973, that the press and public be excluded for the following item of business on the agenda, on the grounds that it involved the likely disclosure of exempt information in terms of paragraph 1 of Part 1 of Schedule 7(A) of the Act.

2. Appeal Against Dismissal.

With reference to the Minutes of 26th July 2011 (Page 465, paragraph 2), when it had been decided to continue consideration of the appeal to this meeting to allow further submissions to be heard, the Chair reconvened the meeting and the hearing resumed.

The appellant, a former employee of the Directorate of Development and Environment, was in attendance and represented by J. Winter, Unite the Union. M. Newall, Head of Planning and Enterprise, represented the Council and was accompanied by W. Wesson, Senior HR Officer.

The Panel heard further evidence from both parties and, after questions, both parties withdrew.
