Subject: Support for Community Planning 2011/12

1. Purpose

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to seek members' approval of funding support for community planning in 2011/12.

2. Recommendations

2.1 Members are requested to:

- note the level of funding for community planning in the 2011/12 revenue budget; and
- approve the allocation of funding to individual projects.

3. Background

- 3.1 Revenue support for Councils includes funding to support community planning, and it is for each Council to determine how much funding is allocated for this purpose.
- 3.2 The Community Planning Partnership has requested £1,582,602 of support from South Ayrshire Council as detailed in *Appendix 1*.
- 3.3 This request has been considered by elected members, and an overall allocation will be determined as part of the 2011/12 revenue budget.
- 3.4 In order to avoid any potential conflict of interest for elected members who sit on the Community Planning Board, the allocation across individual items is being determined as a separate item.

4. Resource Implications

- 4.1 The level of funding available will be determined as part of the 2011/12 revenue budget.

- 5.1 There has been no public consultation about this report.
